How it began...

Florence Peterson had a vision to ensure that charitable programs in the Akron community were supported now and in the future. In 2001, she planted the first seeds of giving through a gift from her estate to establish an endowment within the Siouxland Community Foundation for the exclusive benefit of the Akron, Iowa community. The Akron Community Foundation (ACF) now serves as a vehicle to receive gifts from individuals, families, businesses, and organizations. The ACF endowment fund will provide funding for grant awards for years to come.

About ACF

The Akron Community Foundation is a charitable foundation created by and for the people of Akron to receive gifts from individuals, families, corporations, private foundations, and governmental agencies. All gifts received are carefully invested and the income from the endowment is used to make grants to 501(c)3 non-profits or units of local government that best meet the needs of the community in Akron. An advisory board appointed by position is responsible for governing the ACF.

Charitable Giving

The Foundation serves as a vehicle to carry out the charitable objectives of donors and offers distinct advantages.

Simplicity - One contribution can address a wide range of donor interests to benefit one or a number of community needs.

Permanence - A gift to an endowment fund will continue to provide benefits in perpetuity.

Tax Benefits - All contributions are deductible to the greatest extent allowed by law. Gifts to the Akron Community Foundation endowment may be eligible for the endow Iowa tax credit. Contact the Foundation for more information.

Shared Interests - We work with you, the donor, to guarantee that charitable support is distributed according to your intent.



Ways to Give

You may make a gift of cash, securities, IRA distribution, real estate, life insurance, personal property . . . or by a bequest, trust arrangement, or retirement plan assets. Memorial gifts are also accepted.

Contributions to endowed funds are never spent. Only the investment income is used for making grants and scholarships. Thus a contribution to an endowment fund is a gift that will perpetually benefit the community.
