How it began...

With a vision for the future, Erlene Kading wanted to ensure that charitable programs in the community were supported now and in the future. In 1998, she planted the first seeds of giving through a gift from her estate to establish an endowment within the Siouxland Community Foundation for the exclusive benefit of the Ireton community. Thus, the Ireton Community Foundation (ICF) was created.

About ICF

The Ireton Community Foundation is a charitable foundation created by and for the people of Ireton to receive gifts from individuals, families, corporations, private foundations, and governmental agencies. All gifts received are carefully invested and the income from the endowment is used to make grants to 501(c)3 non-profits or units of local government that best meet the needs of the community in Ireton. An advisory board appointed by position is responsible for governing the ICF.

Charitable Giving

The Foundation serves as a vehicle to carry out the charitable objectives of donors and offers distinct advantages.

Simplicity - One contribution can address a wide range of donor interests to benefit one or a number of community needs.

Permanence - A gift to an endowment fund will continue to provide benefits in perpetuity.

Tax Benefits - All contributions are deductible to the greatest extent allowed by law. Gifts to the Ireton Community Foundation endowment may be eligible for the endow Iowa tax credit. Contact the Foundation for more information.

Shared Interests - We work with you, the donor, to guarantee that charitable support is distributed according to your intent.



Ways to Give

You may make a gift of cash, securities, IRA distribution, real estate, life insurance, personal property . . . or by a bequest, trust arrangement, or retirement plan assets. Memorial gifts are also accepted.

Contributions to endowed funds are never spent. Only the investment income is used for making grants and scholarships. Thus a contribution to an endowment fund is a gift that will perpetually benefit the community.

Mission Statement

The Ireton Community Foundation strives to enhance the quality of life in the Ireton area by seeking charitable gifts to build permanent endowments as charitable capital for the community, providing a flexible vehicle to receive and distribute gifts of any size, making grants in response to community needs, and providing services that will help shape the well-being of Ireton.
