- Adjusted Gross Income (AGI)***: A text input field containing "\$ 25,000.00". The label asks, "What is your families AGI? This can usually be found on line 11 of the most recent 1040 Tax Form".
- Total number of family members living in household?***: A text input field containing "# 3". The label asks, "This number would be those that are primarily supported by the reported income. Include yourself, parents/guardians and other dependents.".
- Total number in household that will attending college at least half time?***: A text input field containing "# 1". The label asks, "This is the total number in your household, including yourself, that will be attending college at least half time during the upcoming academic year".

Some scholarships require a recommendation called Character Counts. This is an online form your recommender completes. You will input the email of the person you have spoken to about recommending you. You will send them an email and they will receive a link to complete an online questionnaire. If multiple scholarships require a Character Counts it will work for all scholarship opportunities that require a recommendation. You cannot have different recommenders for different scholarships. Scholarships can require anywhere from one to three recommendations. NOTE: The Character Counts is not a recommendation letter it is an online form that is completed. You will not be able to see the responses, but you will be able to see they responded.

You can hit save anytime while working in an application. You can hit the home button at the top of screen to see all the scholarships you have available. You can see if your recommenders have responded to your Character Counts on the third-party portion. If the scholarship required three and you sent three requests, it will show how many have responded of the three requests. If your third-party does not respond they will receive a reminder in seven days.

NOTE: Ultimately you are responsible for making sure your recommenders have responded.

Incomplete applications will be disqualified so make sure you have spoken to your recommenders.

Frequently Asked Questions:

Can I submit before my third parties have responded? Yes. We encourage you to complete your application(s) as soon as possible. But remember you are ultimately responsible for making sure your third party has responded. You can log into your dashboard at any time to check on the status. Your third party will receive an automatic email reminder after seven days if they have not responded to your request.

Do I have to apply for all the scholarships that I qualify for? No. You can abandon the request on an opportunity you don't want to apply for. Situations do arise that this could happen.

Do I have to have all different recommenders? No. If you qualify for several scholarships and two scholarships require three Character Counts recommendations, they can and will be the same. Once a recommender completes the online Character Counts recommendation it will update all applications that require the Character Counts.

What happens if I change my college or major? Some scholarships are college specific and/or major specific. An example: The Macfarlane Family Scholarship requires that you must be attending Iowa State to receive this scholarship. If you are awarded this scholarship and you do not attend Iowa State it will be rescinded and awarded to an alternate that is attending Iowa State. The Siouxland Community Foundation administers many scholarships that do not have a specific college or major requirement.
